visitors. The children were given a tour of the facilities, including a talk from a microbiologist about the life cycle of these amazing creatures. They were able to see the fascinating progression from lobster egg to adult. They learned about their conservation and research work, the wider

marine environment and why we should protect it. The group had a fantastic visit and were keen to share this with their friends when they returned. The rest of Year 5 will be visiting The National Lobster Hatchery after half term.






