Reception and Years 1 and 2 from 5:00pm until 6:00pm and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 from 6:15pm until 7:15pm.







#### Year R - Coco

For her fantastic phonics skills and for the effort Sophie has put into the presentation of her work. Keep up the amazing work Sophie!



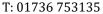


Year 2 – Peyton

For creating an amazing 3D model of a volcano, showing super skills in building and sticking materials together. Lowen also supported his peers with their models. Well done Lowen!







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
