


I hope that you and your families are all safe and well. We have had a full and exciting week in our academy.



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

For working hard and using his phonics to write two independent sentences about our class book 'Six Dinner Sid'. Well done Spencer!




### Year 1 - Reuban

For great independent work in English reading comprehension. Zoey made super use of a dictionary to find the meaning and spelling of new technical vocabulary. Well done Zoey!

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
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### Year 4 - William
