<u>Year 6 – Mini Medics Course</u>

We are delighted to announce that last week, all Year 6 children completed their 'mini medics' course and passed their assessments. They were all thrilled to receive their certificates confirming they are joining a nation of lifesavers. Mr Matthews, a paramedic, and our own Miss Pedley, a qualified first responder from South West Ambulance Service carried out the assessments. The children demonstrated their ability to perform CPR on a resuscitation dummy device, how to use a

defibrillator and place the patient in the recovery position. They were also assessed on their ability to respond to a patient who is choking. This was demonstrated using a choking vest to show the effectiveness of an abdominal thrust. Mr Matthews was



extremely impressed with their knowledge and capabilities. Congratulations and well done to all Year 6 children.



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Year 6 London Residential



From Wednesday to Friday last week, 25 of our Year 6 children attended the London residential.
