





### **COVID Cases Rising**

Public Health Englands <u>weekly COVID-19 variant cases data</u> show that numbers of the Delta (VOC-21APR-02) variant in the UK have risen by 33,630 since last week to a total of 75,953.

Cornwall has seen a significant increase in positive cases and currently has the second highest transmission rate in the country.

With this in mind, please can I kindly ask:

- All parents/carers to strictly maintain social distancing whilst on the school site
- All parents/carers to wear a face mask unless they are medically exempt.
- Only one parent/carer to escort their child/children to the class door where necessary.



### Year R - Lola


