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#### <u> Road Closure – Treeve Lane</u>

We have been advised today by the contractor, Glanvilles, who are working on behalf of South West Water, that part of Treeve Lane between Parc Upton Farm and No. 39 Treeve Lane will be closed from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Please see the letter we received from South West Water and a plan showing the area to be closed sent with today's newsletter. This will mean that the road outside of

Connor Downs Academy will be taking more 'heavy traffic' both accessing the essential works, but also from CIB Lello Plant Hire, whose lorries and machinery usually access their yard using the road down to Hayle rather than past the school. South West Water and the contractor Glanvilles, are working with the school and local residents to ensure the impact of the essential works is kept to a minimum.

Staff in school will be reminding children of the importance of road safety, particularly during this time. We would be very grateful if parent/carers could remind their children of road safety in preparation for the commencement of this work.

#### Homework Grids

We hope you will enjoy discussing the new homework grid sent home today. These grids are full of fun ideas for children and their parents or other family members to try at home.

The activities are entirely optional although we hope lots of children and families will take part!

For skilfully using left, right, forwards and backwards to describe position and direction.


#### Year 3 – Jake

For his really positive and cheerful attitude to his learning. Caleb has a great enthusiasm for everything he does. Keep up the super effort Caleb!

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


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#### Year 5 - Macey
