

to move through the jungles!






In Year 2, the children have looked at the many roles of the Queen. The children wrote diary entries

COVID-19 Asymptomatic Staff Testing Programme Across Aspire Academies

For writing an engaging diary entry of a day in the life of the Queen with excellent spellings and punctuation.




Year 3 – Violet
