We would like to say a huge thank you to the Gwinear-Gwithian Sustainable Community Fund for all their support with this project and with previous


projects, including solar panels, a rain water harvesting

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


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Connor Downs Academy Pentathlon

Covid update reminder

Thank you for your ongoing support with following Covid guidance. Since March 2020, when we experienced our first lockdown, your support in adhering to Covid measures has been tremendous. This has enabled our school to run smoothly and our children to be able to access their education, with no bubble closures to date. The government updated their Step 4 guidance last week and following a full review of this guidance, our plans for opening next week until the end of this academic term are as detailed below.

Essentially, what this means for us is:

- The staggered drop offs and pick ups which are currently in place will continue to the end of term
- The bubbles will remain intact
- The children will continue to have lunches in their classrooms

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- The staff will continue to provide learning following their current timetables
- Face coverings are no longer recommended in communal areas (Again, should there be a local outbreak this may be reintroduced for a fixed time period). However, all parents/carers and staff continue to have the right to wear face coverings in communal areas, should they decide to, based on their own personal circumstances.
- Social distancing however, remains important and I would kindly ask all parents/carers to continue to adhere to social distancing measures. Thank you.

The last day of the summer term is **Thursday 22nd July 2021**. It will be a normal school uniform day finishing at the usual times.

The Autumn term begins on **Tuesday 7th September 2021 for years 1 to 6**. Please note that gates will open at 08:30am and close at 08:45am. Year R have been contacted individually with transition details.

For being a brilliant team player in den building and showing kindness to his friends. Reuban has also produced a super response in English Comprehension.




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




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For his fabulous efforts in maths this week. Riley has really pushed himself with his multiplication work. Well done Riley!
