Thank you for your co-operation and support with our COVID-19 opening plans. The staggered drop offs and pick-ups are working well before and after school. Thank you to everyone for adhering to your allocated times and for following the yellow, social distancing markers on the school grounds.

The children are adapting to the changes to routine in school well and are settling back into school life. Thank you for your support with this and for your many positive comments.

Some common questions which have arisen are over hand washing and face masks.

Hand washing

To clarify our position on hand washing, we have a daily routine of hand washing for all children. This includes washing hands on arrival to school, before and after morning break, before and after lunch and after coughing and sneezing. Children are using tissues for coughs and sneezes and are following the 'Catch it, bin, kill it' phrase to remind them of the need to use tissues to catch germs. Children are using water and hand soap to wash their hands and are supervised washing hands for at least twenty seconds. Hand sanitiser is not being used as handwashing, along with killing germs, also physically removes much dirt and debris from the skins surface.


