I hope that you and your families are well. We have had another busy and exciting week!




#### Science Workshop at Nexus

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#### <u>SumDog – The Aspire Academy Trust Contest</u>

The Aspire Academy Trust SumDog Contest for October is here!

Between 08:00 today, 8<sup>th</sup> October and 20:00 on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> October, your child/children can take part in the contest.

- Your child/children can play at any time.
- For their score to count, the 'The Aspire Academy Trust' activity must be showing in the green panel on the left of your child/children's screen when they click to start each game.
- Their scores are based on correct answers and a class's score will be the average of the scores from all students within that class who take part.
- To appear on the leader board, at least five children from a class need to take part.
- Every child is limited to 1000 contest questions, to allow those with limited computer access the ability to take part.



#### **Parent/Carer Consultations**

We are delighted to announce that this year we are able to hold face to face parent/carer consultations in line with current guidance. These consultations will take place on the evenings of Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> October and Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> October, with meetings available in 10 minute slots between 3:30pm and 6:10pm each evening. To book a consultation with your child/ren's teacher/s, please do so using the Arbor App. Bookings will **open from 5:00pm on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> October** and **close at 5:00pm on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> October**.

The consultations will take place in your child/s classroom/s, with books available outside of the classroom/s for you to review while waiting. Please remain in the corridor until you are called into the classroom. We would ask that:

- Each parent takes a Lateral Flow Test on the day of the appointment
- You arrive no more than 10 minutes before your appointment time
- All parents/carers sanitise hands on arrival at the main school reception
- Wear face masks at all times while on site unless exempt.
- Remain socially distanced as much as possible from other parents/carers

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#### **Reminders**

As the weather has now turned more autumnal, please can we remind parents/carers to ensure their child comes to school with a warm, waterproof coat every day. We are encouraging the children to get some fresh air at all break and lunch times as well as taking advantage of our amazing outdoor area during lesson times, so it is vital that your child has a coat to wear to keep them as dry and warm as possible.

Naturally, with the colder weather comes more illness, in terms of colds, sickness bugs etc. If your child/children has a bout of sickness or diarrhoea, the school policy is the requirement for them to kept away from school for 48 hours from the last occurrence.

Please can we also remind parents/carers, that if your child/children is/are absent from school due to illness, please ensure you telephone the school every morning they are absent and leave a message on the absence line. Thank you.

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#### Chance to Shine Cricket


We are delighted to invite Piran Kent (level 2 cricket coach) to Connor Downs Academy to provide a sixweek block of cricket coaching.

#### Year R - Finlay


For outstanding effort in maths. As part of Reception's World Space Week learning, Finlay used colour to create a fantastic repeating pattern rocket collage.






Year 1 - Elsie B

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




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#### Year 4 – Amelia B
