




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Year R – Sponsored Welly Walk - Tehidy Woods


Christmas Events Reminders


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Christmas Dinner

For persevering with following instructions for making paper snowflakes. William showed great leadership skills in working well in his group, on final construction of the snowflake and evaluating the instructions that they followed.










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Year 5 – Alfie
