Covid Update

Earlier this week you will have received a letter from Vanessa Bragg, CEO of Aspire, detailing the current information regarding our Covid measures.

You will have seen in the press that due to the high rates of infection across the South West at the moment, Cornwall and Devon have been moved to an Enhanced Response Area (ERA) by central government. This means that authorities across the South West have more flexibility to introduce public health measures if considered necessary.

For settling in so well to your first week at Connor Downs Academy. Well done to all the children in Year R!


Year 1 - Lowen
