Also, a big thank you to Mrs Hollis and Mrs Rees who accompanied us on the visit.



Bags To School – Reminder







Year R – Arthur

For his fantastic effort in his Phonics. Barney has a great attitude towards his learning and is a great role model I Year 1. Well done Barney!






Year 3 – Lola
