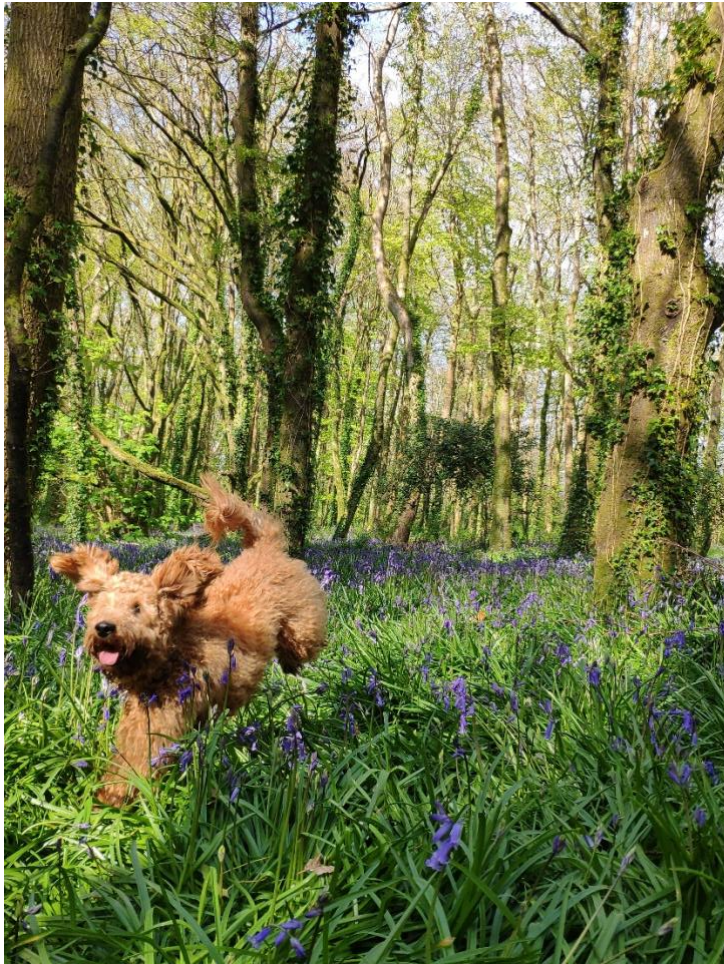


Hello Year 1,

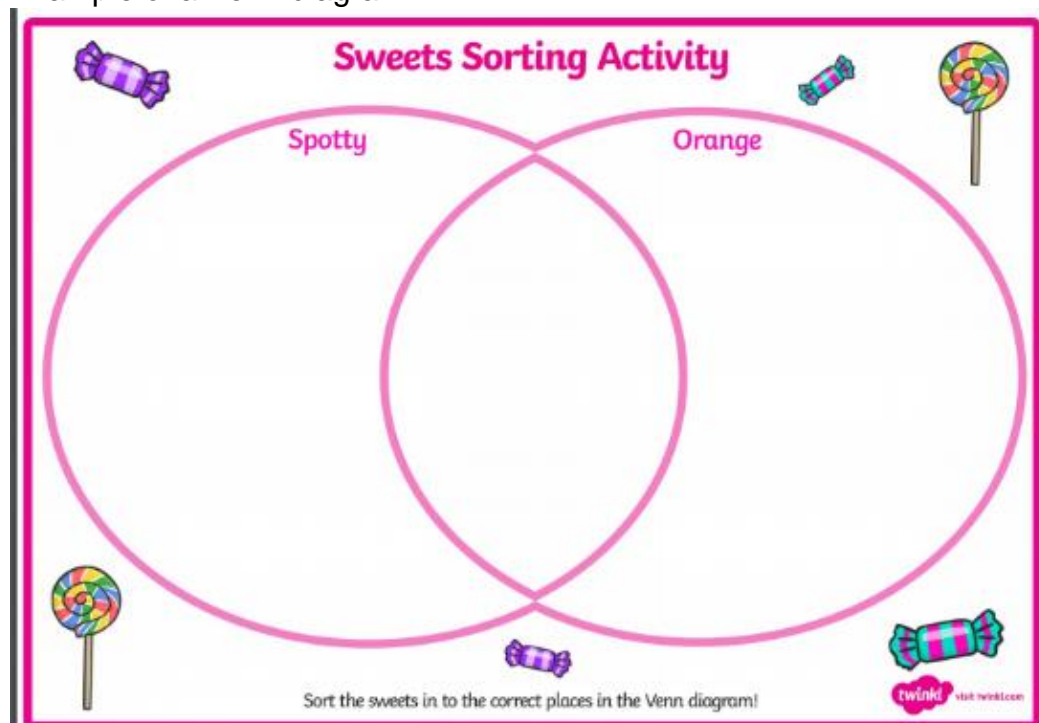

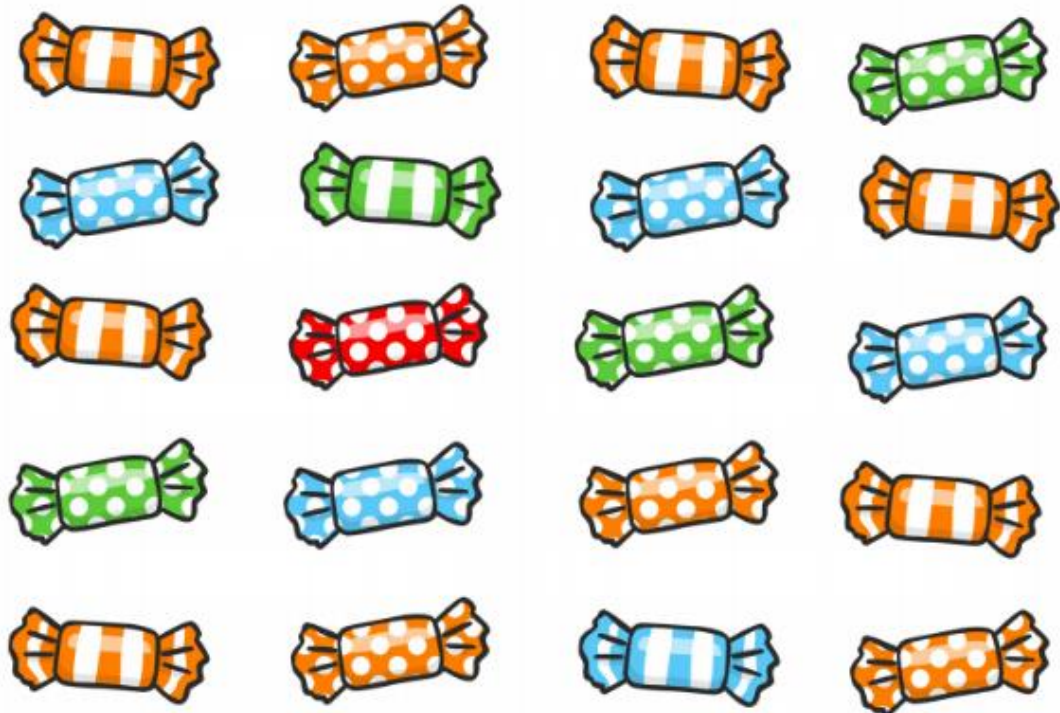
- Look at the adjectives that are used to describe each animal. How many other adjectives can you think of to describe them? (English)



- Can you sort the animals in the story using a Venn diagram? Which ones have two legs? Which have four legs? Which ones have a beak or a nose? How many other ways could you sort them? (maths)

Example of a Venn diagram:





- How many different animals appear in the story? How are they similar / different? (science)
- Design a new crown for the Queen to wear. (art)
- Can you make up a song which includes lots of examples of animal sounds? (music)
- Try to find where different zoos are in your local area. What animals do they look after? (geography)
- Think about what stealing means and why it is wrong. How would you feel if someone stole from you? What happens to people who steal things from others? (PSHE)
