Last week, in celebration of World Space Week, Reception enjoyed sharing the story 'Whatever Next?' by Jill Murphy. In the story, Baby Bear uses his imagination to travel to the moon in a rocket. He even meets an alien! Inspired by Baby Bear's

creativity, the children enjoyed creating unique rocket collages, using primary colours to create a repeating pattern.

children also enjoyed participating in a building

challenge, using stimuli to construct rockets and space stations in the block provision. This was a fantastic way for the children to

practise teamwork, develop their resilience and learn all about the properties of 3D shapes.

...look at the admission arrangements on our website that will be used to allocate places for each school.

...consider naming your **nearest or designated school** as one of your preferences. You can find your nearest or designated school on our website.

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


Connor Downs Academy Shining Stars Friday 15th October 2021

Year 1 - Tommy


