On Wednesday, Year 4 visited Carn Euny ancient village site at Sancreed near Penzance as part of their geography topic on settlements.

The children spent the day surveying the settlement, looking for resources that the original inhabitants would have needed to

build their courtyard roundhouse structures.

They reviewed the location and the area that surrounds the village - where they could find arable land and where the nearest water source was located.





Everyone had fun

exploring the beenive room and the fogou (although recent rainfall meant that only those with the tallest wellies were able to traverse the entire fogou!)

The children had plenty of fresh air and exercise with a walk up to the holy well and then back along the farm track to the minibuses before returning to school.
