The children were able to handle replicas of Stone Age pots and tools, dress in Iron age tunics and create their own Bronze coin design. The museum staff commented on the excellent behaviour, knowledge and


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Christmas Fayre

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


Connor Downs Academy Shining Stars Friday 3rd December 2021

Year 3 - Mabel


